A Family Affair

Fourth Generation Psi Tom McMillan III '92 Impressed with Leadership

From the very beginning, DKE has played a big part in the life of **Tom McMillan III '92**. Born just a few miles from the chapter house, Tom's father, **Thomas McMillan Jr. '71**, joked that a DKE pledge pin was placed on his diaper. Not only was Tom's father a member of the Psi Chapter, four generations of McMillan men have lived within the walls of the mansion on the hill. His great-grandfather, **Edward L. McMillan 1909**, and grandfather, **Thomas E. McMillan '35**, were also Psi brothers.

Despite his family history with DKE, Tom kept his options open when he started college at Alabama. "Joining a fraternity is a big commitment and I wanted to make the best decision for myself. As it turned out, joining DKE was the best choice." Not only did he continue the family legacy, but he formed strong bonds with his pledge brothers that strengthen each year. Since graduation Tom and his pledge brothers have been able to get together for a reunion each year, further strengthening their friendship and bonds of brotherhood.
