On behalf of the Campaign Executive Board, we thank each of you who has participated in the efforts to build our new Chapter House. To date, we have received \$2,832,579 in pledges from 279 brothers. It has been gratifying to have so many of you support this vital project and to hear the many words of encouragement.

Even with our success to date, we have a long way to go in reaching our campaign goal. It will take the support of all brothers to ensure completion of the project and our financial stability. An additional \$3,467,421 in pledges is needed to complete the construction project as envisioned.

That being said, construction is moving along. Some major highlights of the 25,000 square foot Chapter House include a state-of-the-art kitchen, housemother suite, 29 single-man rooms with shared or private bathrooms, computer facilities, an enlarged dining room, and a new Chapter room. The construction will also address all mandatory building and fire regulations.

Most important is what has been accomplished with our active membership. You will all be impressed with the quality young men of the Psi Chapter. These men are leaders in the classroom, on campus, and in the community. This spring the Psi Chapter finished in the top 10 in G.P.A. ranking among all 28 fraternities.
